SUMMARY OF THE REPORT AND 2009 FUNDING REQUEST FROM COLEGIO NUESTRA SEÑORA DE FATIMA FOR SUSILA DHARMA INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION – AMANECER, DECEMBER 2008

During 2008, the Nuestra Señora de Fatima School provided an education for 25 rural children in grades ranging from kindergarten to fourth grade. For 2009, the greatest challenge, in addition to improving the physical facilities that are quite damaged, will be to assemble a team of teachers, pedagogues and administrative staff who, under the guidance of the Latihan, will help us to develop a pedagogic teaching model that will bring about a real awakening of human culture, strengthening and increasing the education service with social emphasis.

The Institutional Education Project (**IEP**) is a collective dynamic creation, modified and strengthened by the entire educational community, product of our search for the professional improvement and permanent training of the institution.

Below, there is a summary of the activities and accomplishments in the year 2008, with the account statements through November 30, and our projections for the next year in 2009.

Please receive our feelings of gratitude and affection for all of you who have always been present in the educational and social development of Amanecer.

REPAIRS TO THE INFRASTRUCTURE

- ✓ Repairs made to the School's bathrooms. See Photo 1 attached.
- ✓ Improved facilities. We have projected a budget for the improvement of all the facilities, which have been in use for more than 9 years.
- ✓ Preschool Activity Room: Repairing the Kiosk to be completed by December 26, 2008 with an investment from the Fundacion Amanecer of USD \$3450. See Photo 2 attached.
- ✓ Playground: Put together with the cooperation of the parents.
- ✓ Computer Room: Bought a computer, but we need at least two others.

COMMUNITY SERVICE PROGRESS

Embera Chami indigenous community. This project is focused on strengthening their community development, based on a diagnosis that helped to identify the following requirements:

Nutrition for children and pregnant women, food assistance, youth training, and

strengthening community relations by identifying rights and duties, according to their standards of living. Some links were made with government institutions such SENA, ICBF and the Mayor's Office of Cordoba City, in order to provide greater support for this community.

With the support of SDI, we began the creation of a "Community Home" for the Embera Chami. This process was very difficult, so the ICBF decided to build a Community Kitchen. This process is still just beginning, so we have only sent some photos of the community and the site where this project will operate. See Photos 3 and 4 attached.

INTER-INSTITUTIONAL CONVENTIONS

An agreement was established with the Universidad del Quindio, to set up an exchange with undergraduate students in Environmental Biology and to develop a vegetable garden at the School. Please see Photo 5 attached.

Another agreement was with the Educational Institution "La Popa", in order to provide educational services to students who complete elementary school education in the Amanecer School.

EDUCATIONAL AND TECHNICAL PROCESSES MODEL

The School's **IEP** emphasizes human values as the core of our educational activities. For this reason, the Quindio Education Secretary issued a favorable certificate of recognition to the Amanecer School for its contribution to the welfare of low-income children, including indigenous communities. The collection of these documents was also of great help in order to be classified in the "Banco de Oferentes" of the Ministry of Education during 2007.

PEDAGOGICAL ADVISORY

FA hired an educational expert for his professional services, Dr. Elio Fabio Gutierrez, who designed and renovated the following components:

- ✓ Review and improve the School Guidelines, adding a chapter which defines the tuition fee as a contract to provide educational services.
- ✓ Reshape the Preschool curriculum based on educational contests.
- ✓ Define the Educational Model that guides the actions of the institution. This process is a priority for 2009.
- ✓ Improve the conceptual presentation of educational projects, identifying clusters of knowledge and how these are incorporated into the curriculum.
- ✓ Improve the hiring conditions for teachers.
- ✓ Augment the scope of English classes to include Preschool.
- ✓ Develop and implement the Annual Training Plan for Teachers

We have made progress in the curriculum, but we still have much to work on. Our commitment is to achieve the total development of all the plans.

PROJECTION FOR THE YEAR 2009

The Board members of FA have the desire and enthusiasm to continue strengthening and projecting our goals, in the social and educational fields, through our Amanecer School and "Semillitas" Community Home.

ADMINISTRATIVE MANAGEMENT

Attend to all of the requirements and formal recommendations made by the Education Secretary, as possible. In this way, each year we will improve the annual qualification received by the School. This is very important, because it allows us to be able to carry out agreements with the Colombian government in the future.

Implement the standard procedures developed in 2008, so that all the areas of FA are unified in their administrative systems.

Intensify marketing actions during the year of 2009.

Advertising, monitoring and the delivery of reports of our program via the Subud Network for Teaching ("En Red Subud Educa"). See attached sheet.

Building a new classroom with the cooperation of SDI and SYA's "Volunteers Without Tears" (VWT) Program. It is also necessary to improve the provision of furniture, teaching materials and the computer room.

Continue the accompaniment and follow-up of the indigenous Embera Chami

Enlarge the number of students in the School, facilitating financial help through the "En Red Subud Educa" Program.

ACADEMIC MANAGEMENT

Attend to and develop all of the activities required by the government Education Secretary.

Finish the curriculum project.

Continue to work on the Pedagogic Teaching Model.

INTER-INSTITUTIONAL MANAGEMENT

Strengthen links with the education sector, inside and outside of Subud.

Establish agreements with government entities for consultancy services, library organization, educational facilities loans, and projects dealing with biology and the environment.

Develop a directory of educational NGOs, as an opportunity to exchange experiences and support.

Facilitate exchanges with other successful educational institutions.

Other initiatives developed by teachers or School directives.

INMEDIATELY REQUIREMENTS

Teacher training is required by the Ministry of Education, to continue upgrading educational institutions, while strengthening the conditions of teamwork and projection towards future developments.

Didactic materials are urgently needed to start the teaching work in February, 2009, in addition to replacing those damaged by use. In the subject of geography, maps are needed, through which children can learn about the breadth and the beauty of the world.

One of the priority recommendations of the Ministry of Education is to have a

computer room, with a minimum of two computers, Internet connections, and software to consult virtual libraries.

Amanecer has been chosen to host the first work camp of youth volunteers, in July 2009, organized by SDI and SYA. The FA Board decided that this project will benefit the School, with the building of one classroom. This classroom already has the basement, so the investment required is smaller, but we need the money to buy the building materials.

The "En Red Subud Educa" program aims to expand educational services focusing on vulnerable population sectors, such as children from the "Semillitas" Community Home, indigenous communities, children with learning disabilities or school adaptation difficulties, and children whose mothers are heads of households.

The Amanecer School has been working for seven years without interruption. It is one of our programs that has allowed us to express our institutional goals and the awakening of our sensitivity towards the communities around us, establishing a solidarity network that extends to other families and communities, making children happy and thus becoming a source of peace, in a similar way to how the Latihan Kejiwan has been spread among human beings.

The FA gives thanks once again for your permanent and unconditional support. We share the feeling that our foundations have woven threads of union between us, which over the years have allowed us to learn and gain experience in the development of social and educational programs, and also for the coexistence with others and the search for peace, in a fraternity with so many shades and diversity like ours.
